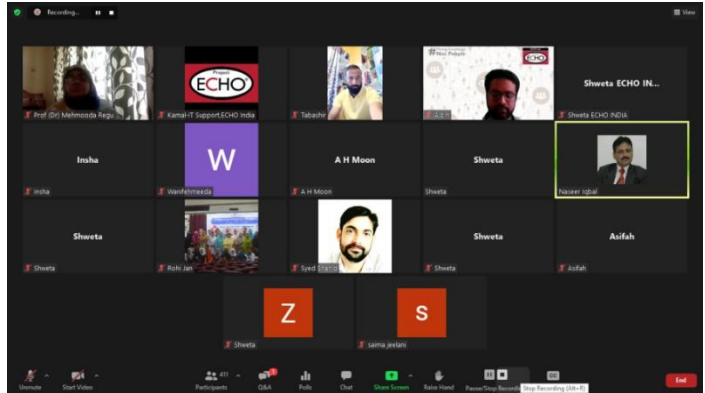


AMCNMT -IUST hosts Three Day Webinar on 'Latest Trends in Nursing Education'
