- Accepted abstracts will be notified through email (Authors must provide a valid email address with each abstract submission) on 11 November, 2023
- > Upon acceptance of abstracts, full papers must be submitted by 16 November 2023

Research Paper and Abstract Format

- Word Limit is 3000 to 5000 words for full research papers and 250-300 for abstracts (excluding footnotes). The Research Paper and Abstract should be in: Times New Roman; font size 12 regular and headings in bold; lines spacing 1.15 and alignment "justified"; and footnotes (if any) in Times New Roman, font size 10, with single line spacing.
- The texts and footnotes must conform to APA/Chicago citation style. All the submissions must be in MS-Word document [(.doc)/(.docx)] format only.
- The submission should contain a disclaimer that the paper is original and has not been published or is under consideration for publication elsewhere.
