# Research publications in journals indexed in Scopus or the Web of Science (SCIE/SSCI/AHCI) shall carry 2 marks per paper. Full marks shall be awarded to a single author or where the applicant is both the first and corresponding author; 70% of the marks where the applicant is either the first or corresponding author; and 30% of the marks for joint authorship (other than first or corresponding author).

\* if the period of teaching/Post-doctoral experience is less than one year then the marks shall be reduced proportionately.

**(B)** Where the number of eligible applicants exceeds a reasonable limit for conducting interviews, the University shall undertake shortlisting in conformity with the applicable UGC regulations. However, the number of candidates to be called for interview shall be decided by the University on the basis of merit, overall quality of applicants, and such cutoff score as may be prescribed by the university after screening of applications.

- >75 & up to 80% - 35 points
