Anantnag, 26 May: As part of the University's ongoing Academic Outreach Program, School of Sciences, Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST), conducted comprehensive Outreach Programmes at Government Degree College (GDC) Khanabal and select higher secondary schools in South Kashmir's Anantnag district.
