Subject: Course Classification and Uniform Course Codes.

Reference: University Order No. 91 (Est.) of 2018 dated 01-06-2018

It has been observed that the course classification and the Uniform Course Codes as detailed in the above referred University Order has not been reflected properly by many Departments in their scheme of courses for every semester. The proper classification of courses and uniform course codes shall help the students to easily identify a course and choose their electives accordingly.

For the sake of clarification, the Departments may please note that:

1. **Core Courses:** These are the courses forming basic and fundamental content of a program which are to be compulsory to be studied and for a minimum of 50% of the of the minimum total credit requirements of the program,.
2. **Elective Courses:** These are the courses which can be chosen from a pool of papers that are supportive to the discipline of Study. Elective Courses may further be divided into two categories:
 - a. **Discipline Centric Electives:** These are the courses which are offered within the Department in a particular semester and the students have the option to choose from them.
 - b. **Generic Electives:** These are the courses which are offered by different Departments within the School in a particular semester and the students have the option to choose from them.
3. **Open Electives:** These are courses which are preferably unrelated to the discipline of nurture proficiencies / skill and the open elective of any particular Department would only be offered to students enrolled in pogramme outside the department and forma minimum of 5% of the minimum total credit requirement of the program.
4. **Foundation Courses:** These are courses at the undergraduate level required for building general proficiency and awareness amongst students .

Furthermore, in view of the introduction of 5 year undergraduate programmes at the University, the Clause 2 of the Policy under Uniform course Code is substituted as follows:

"The numeral following the two alphabets would indicate the level of the course, 1 to 5 for undergraduate 1st to 5th year; 6 to 7 for post graduate 1st to 2nd year; and 8 for Ph.D".

All the departments are requested to classify the courses in each semester according to the course classification and uniform course code and submit the same to the office of Dean Academic Affairs by or before **20-01-2022**.


