Ensuring the safety and well-being of hostel residents is a top priority at IUST. Each girl in Jhelum hostel is secured by dedicated security personnel stationed at all entry and exit points. These guards maintain strict vigilance over all movements in and out of the hostels, verifying identities and monitoring visitor access in accordance with university regulations. In addition to physical security, the hostel premises are under **24/7 CCTV surveillance**, covering common areas, corridors, and access routes to enhance overall campus safety. Students are regularly informed about the security protocols and are encouraged to cooperate with safety measures in place. Periodic security briefings and safety drills are also organized to keep residents aware and prepared. IUST University provides a ragging-free environment in the hostels. Our hostels are supervised by a vigilant and dedicated staff that ensures the safety and well-being of all residents. IUST has established clear mechanisms for the prevention, reporting, and redressal of any such incidents, including proactive sensitization programs and immediate disciplinary action where necessary. In keeping with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, UGC regulations, State Government mandates, and the University's own code of conduct, all forms of ragging are strictly prohibited and dealt with under a **zero-tolerance policy**. This robust system not only ensures a **ragging-free environment**, but also promotes mutual respect, academic focus, and personal development, making the hostels a secure and welcoming space for all students.
