

Achievements of the Center:

The Center has published many research papers, including a book. It has submitted several major research projects to various national and state funding agencies. The Center has also organized a One Week workshop on Research Methodology in Social Sciences at IUST from 11th - 15th June, 2019 in collaboration with the Anthropological survey of India. The Center successfully introduced an Open Elective course titled “Tribe and Tribal Development” for the academic session 2024 - 25 in sync with National Educational Policy (NEP 2020). Additionally, the Center is planning to establish a museum to preserve the cultural heritage of J&K.

The Centre was awarded to organize a two-week course on Research Methodology in Social Sciences, sponsored by Indian council of Social Science Research (ICSSR). This course was jointly organized by Rinchen Shah Center for Western Himalayan Cultures and Center for International Relations and held from 6th - 16th March, 2018 at Islamic University of Science & Technology, Awantipora.
