Awantipora, Aug 29: The Department of Journalism and Mass Communication (DJMC) at the Islamic University of Science and Technology (IUST) Wednesday organised a field visit to Doordarshan Kendra Srinagar for its television journalism students. The visit under Industry Connect initiative aimed to provide students with first-hand experience of operations at a television broadcasting station particularly the Regional News Unit at DDK.

During their visit, the students visited various facilities and functions within the Kendra including the News Unit, Production Control Rooms, Earth Station, Studios etc. The students had the opportunity to interact with senior officials from Doordarshan Kendra Srinagar, including Deputy Director General (Engineering) S. In line with their practical requirements, the visit provided students with a unique opportunity to witness the behind-the-scenes workings of a television network and were briefed on camera operation, lighting, and editing.

The students were accompanied by Coordinator Industry Connect DJMC Dr. Monisa Qadiri and Instructor in Television Journalism, and Technical Assistant Mr. Zahoor Ahmad.
