



TEN DAY COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAM ON "TEACHER TRAINING"

REPORT



The Department of Arabic Language and Literature, in collaboration with the International Educational Institution "Arabic for All" Riyadh, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, organized a Ten Day outreach program on "Teacher Training" from 3rd – 12th July 2023, in online mode.

"Arabic for All" is an entity based and operating from Riyadh, the capital of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, sponsored the Program. With services available in most countries worldwide, the Program is supervised and managed by an elite of academic specialists in applied linguistics. The event was organized for university and college-level teachers to help them hone their language teaching skills and equip them with the latest methodologies and innovative teaching techniques. A good number of faculty members from different



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
Government Degree Colleges of UT, J&K, including the faculty members from the Department of Arabic, IUST, attended the Training Program.
