December 7, 2023 – Prof. Shakil A Romshoo, IUST today chaired the review meeting of the Centre of Entrepreneurship Development Cell in which the working of the different verticals was assessed and future course of action deliberated upon.

Prof. Romshoo commended the Director CIED and his team for the efforts and accomplishments, particularly for the 4-star ranking awarded by Government of India's Institution Innovation Council (IIC) for nurturing innovation, entrepreneurial ecosystem, and capacity building of the youth.
